1. **Read Mark 14:1-9.** The woman's sacrifice didn't make sense to the disciples. But, Jesus makes it clear that what she did was right. Has there ever been a gift that you have given that doesn't make sense to others? Have you ever witnessed a gift given that just seems crazy?
2. Have you ever found yourself in a situation like the disciples where it looks like a gift is to extravagant and the money could have been used in a better way?
3. We have the perspective of knowing what Jesus was about to do on the cross. The disciples did not and missed the sense of sacrifice this woman was making. How does looking at her gift through the lens of the cross change the extravagance of her gift?
4. How does getting to comfortable in life lead to a lack of generosity in our life as well?
5. What if we knew more about the story of the woman who broke the perfume does that maybe change how we see her sacrifice?
6. **Read John 12:1-3.** Does knowing what Jesus had done for her and her family change if that gift was to extravagant?
7. Talk about a time when you have seen Jesus do something in your life that you couldn't even begin to thank Him for. Does that change how you look at sacrificing for Him?
